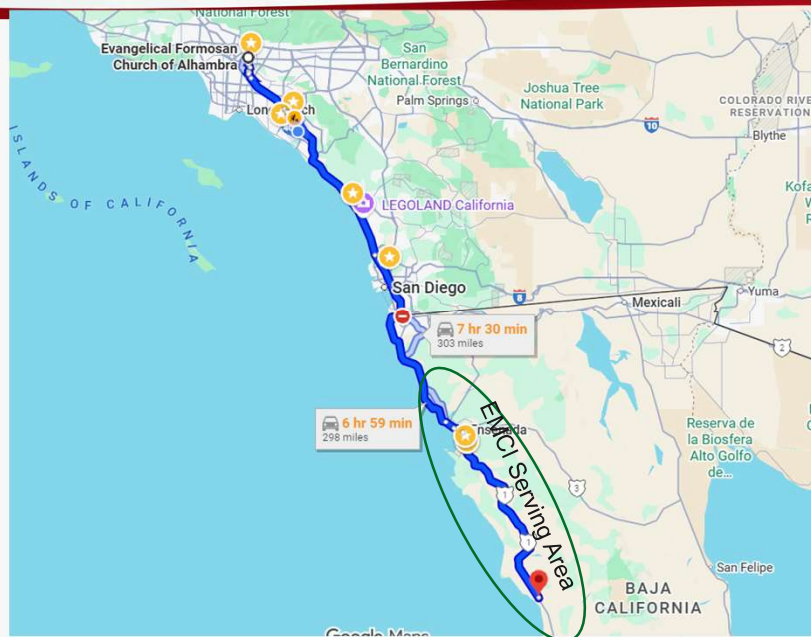

EMCI Mission Center Rules & Guidelines

1. No Food in the Dorm

- To maintain cleanliness and prevent pests, food is not allowed inside the dormitory.
- **Water is permitted.**

2. Shower Guidelines

- Please take short showers to conserve water.
- The water pressure is strong - **remove the showerhead before turning on the water** to prevent splashing.
- The hot-water knob is on the left. Since the water is very hot, please adjust it carefully.

3. Bedding & Cleanliness

- **Bed sheets and pillows are washed and cleaned after each use.**
- Please keep your sleeping area tidy.

4. Respect Quiet Hours

- Keep noise levels low to ensure a comfortable stay for all residents.
- Avoid loud music or conversations, especially during nighttime hours.
- Do not set alarms more than 30 minutes before the gathering time.

5. Personal Belongings

- Keep your belongings organized and respect shared spaces.
- The dorm is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Do not leave your money, passports and FMM in the dorm. You must carry them with you at all time.

6. Lights & Electrical Use

- Turn off lights and electrical appliances when not in use to save energy.
- Unplug chargers and devices when leaving the room.

7. Waste Disposal

- Dispose of trash properly in designated bins.
- Recycle bins are not provided as there are no programs for collecting recycled items.

8. Emergency Procedures

- In case of an emergency, follow posted evacuation routes.
- Contact dorm staff if you need assistance.

By following these rules, we can ensure a clean, safe, and comfortable environment for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation!

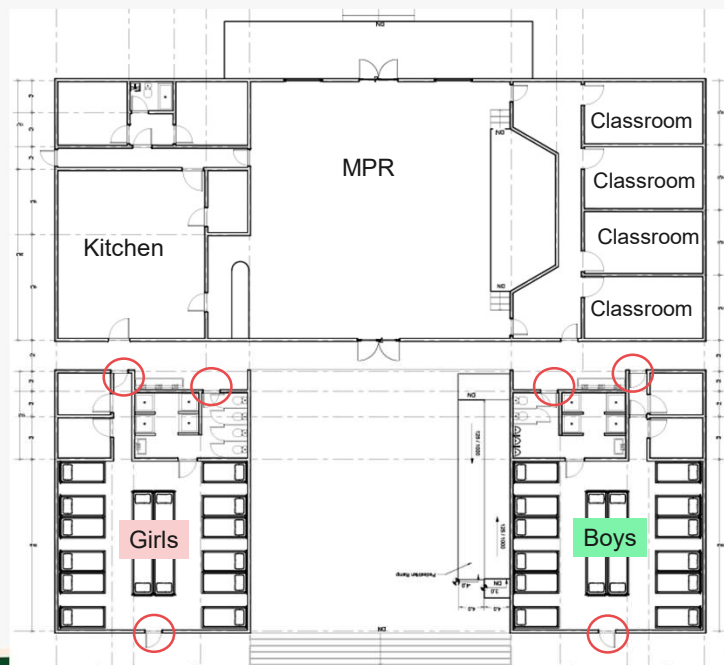

General Rules

Dress Code:

- Dress modestly, avoiding skirts and overly revealing attire.
- Wear sturdy, hard sole, and closed-toe shoes.

Safety Guidelines:

- Always stay in groups of three or more.
- Immediately report any incidents to group leaders or adults.
- Do not feed the dogs.
- Refrain from running, playing aggressively, or giving piggyback rides on the fields.
- Do not bring any valuable items such as iPads, brand-name sunglasses, or expensive earphones.

Health Tips:

- Stay hydrated, especially during construction work and outdoor activities.
- Wear sun-protective clothing, including long-sleeved shirts, pants, hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen.

Child/Youth Protection Code of Conduct

Appropriate Touch:

- Verbal praise
- Side hugs and shoulder to shoulder hugs
- Pats on the shoulder, back, or head
- Touching hands, shoulders, and arms

Do **NOT**:

- Touching buttocks, chests, genital areas, or thighs
- Full body hugs, Kissing, Tickling
- Any behavior that could be interpreted as sexual in nature

Essentials Items on the Mission Trip

- Ensure you have a current and unexpired US passport or Green Card.
- Carry both your passport/green card and FMM visa at all times.
- Bring any necessary medications you take regularly.
- Pack a light sleeping bag
- Toiletries and a towel (shampoo and boy wash are provided)
- Bring a refillable water bottle; drinking water will be available for refills.
- Use soft and lightweight bags, such as old backpacks, for easy transport.

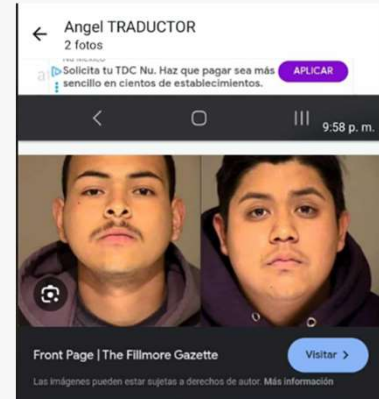

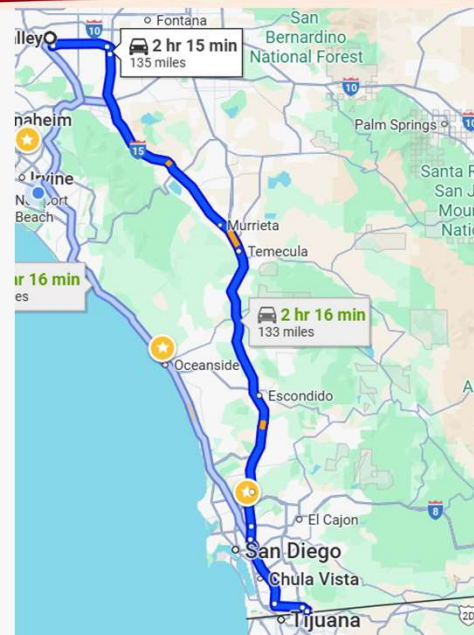

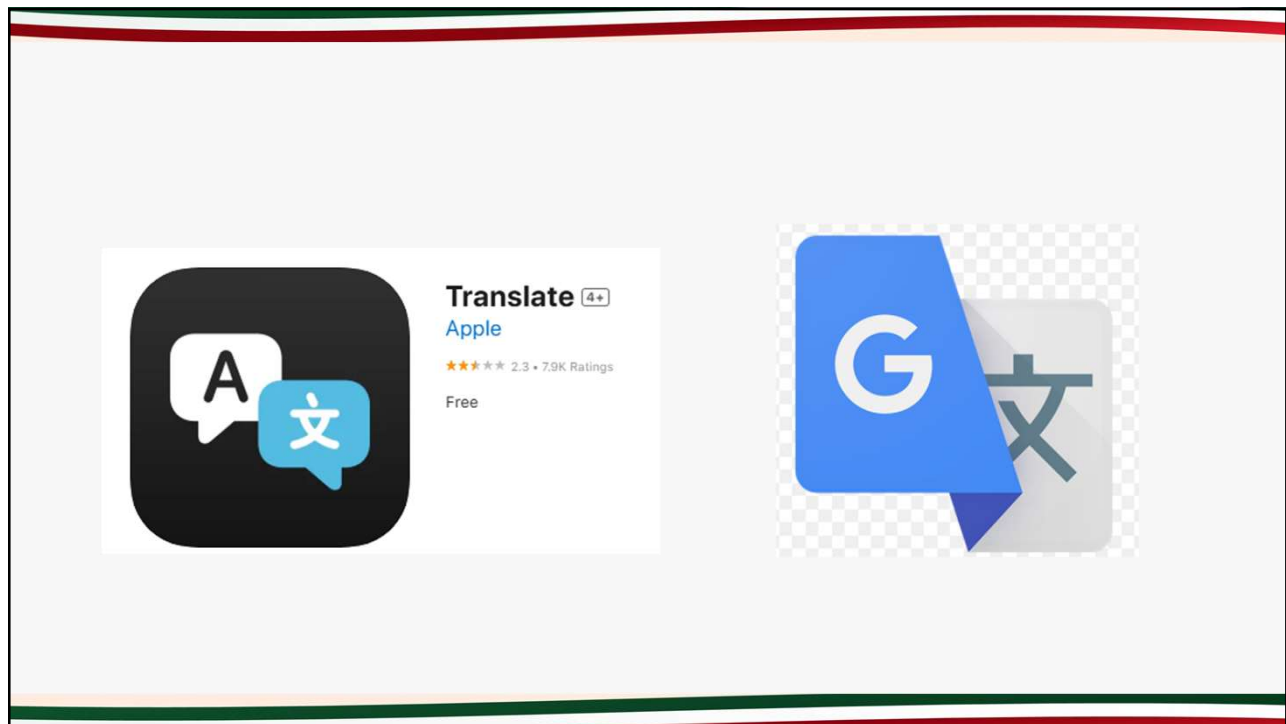
